

Bulky Waste

You may place your bulky items on the curb the fourth full week of each month. Please see the Collection Calendar on the inside panel for Bulky Waste pickup weeks. A maximum of two (2) items will be collected each month per address.

No electronics will be accepted.

- Acceptable items include small furniture, bedding and mattresses.  
-Mattress & box spring sets count as one item.  
Mattresses, box-springs and toilets MUST be securely bagged/wrapped in plastic.
- Carpeting and carpet padding must be taped rolls in lengths of 4 feet or less, and no wider than 18 inches. Four rolls = 1 item
- Large items must be of size that can easily be handled by two people.

Bulk items collection does not include air conditioners, microwave-emitting equipment, tires, and any regulated material covered by the New York State Equipment Recycling Reuse Act, such as televisions and computers.

Household Hazardous Waste Collection

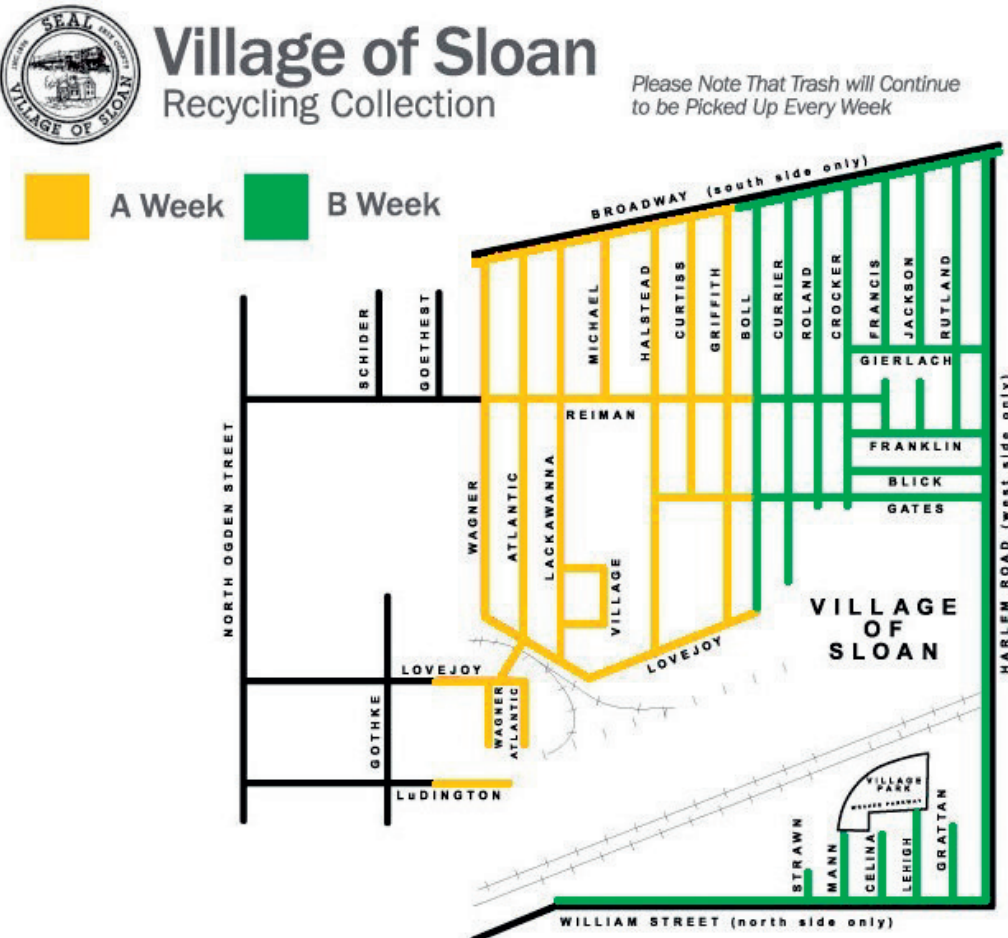

- House and Garden Products - pesticides, fertilizers, pool chemicals, etc.
- Garage Products - automotive fluids such as motor oils, gasoline, antifreeze and brake & transmission fluids
- Workshop/painting products - Oil-based paints, paint strippers and thinners, spray paints, kerosene & other solvents.
- Items NOT accepted - latex paint, alkaline batteries, tires, electronic waste/televisions, asbestos, explosives, smoke detectors, cooking oils, syringes/needles, cylinders of compressed gases, and fluorescent light bulbs or ballasts.

Frequently asked questions

I'm planning to clean out the garage and have a lot of refuse to get rid of right away. Where should i dispose it?

For Sloan residents that have a clean out or construction project the Bagster® Bag could be a solution. you can find the Bagster® Bag at any Home Depot, Lowes, or other local hardware stores. **Schedule**  
Trash and recycling collection will continue on the same schedule that you are on right now. Bulky items will be collected once monthly. All materials should be placed at the curb by 6:00 a.m. on your collection day. Please see the attached calendar on an adjacent panel for collection dates, holiday schedule and bulk collection schedule.

**Trash**  
All regular household refuse must be bagged and placed in your 95-gallon town-provided cart for collection. Materials may not protrude from the cart and the lid must securely close. Please place all trash inside the cart, including grass clippings and yard debris.  
The following items will NOT be accepted in the trash cart:

- Dirt, sod, concrete or rock
- Electronic waste including televisions, computers, etc.
- Construction/demolition debris
- Household hazardous waste
- Hot ashes or flammable materials such as oil, gas or paint

**Care and placement of the carts:**

- Always keep the lid closed to keep rain, snow and animals out.
- Clean the cart periodically
- Since automated waste collection requires clearance for the vehicle's lifting mechanism, any cars parked at the curb should be at least 5 feet from the trash cart.

Keep space between objects and carts.

✗ **POOR Cart Placement**



Objects and cart are too close together.

Place wheels of cart toward house.

The placement of the cart is very important as the collection vehicle's lifting arm requires clearance of at least 3 feet on both sides of the cart and 12 feet overhead. Carts should be no more than 3 feet away from the roads edge, with the arrow facing the road and the handles facing the house.

**If you are located on the parking side of the street, we recommend placing trash and recycling carts on your driveway apron to prevent them from being blocked by vehicles.**

**Recycling**  
Recycling not only conserves precious natural resources, it also helps to reduce costs by decreasing the amount of materials that end up in the landfill.

- Please make every attempt to fit all your recyclable materials inside your recycling containers. As a last resort, large cardboard may be broken down (no larger than 3ft by 3ft), flattened, and neatly placed next to the recycling cart.
- Recycling containers should be placed curbside every other week on the same day as your trash collections. Please refer to the calendar for your recycling schedule.
